Horizon welcomes new Psychiatric Provider, serving adults in the Bedford area.

Bedford, VA – According to the National Institute of Mental Health, approximately one out of every three people with a Severe Mental Illness did not receive mental health treatment in the last year (2020). Similar challenges were expressed by respondents of the Bedford Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) who reported that psychiatric care for adults and pediatrics was hard to find in the community (2021).

Horizon Behavioral Health is proud to announce the recent addition of a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) to their wellness team, now serving adults in the town of Bedford and Bedford County. Christine Gilmore, PMHNP, comes to the central Virginia region from New Mexico with 12 years of experience as a Nurse Practitioner. While practicing in a variety of settings including urgent care, home care, primary care, and outpatient primary care, Christine recognized that there was a bleak disconnect between the number of psychiatric referrals she needed to make and the number of Psychiatric Providers able to receive them. When asked what was the most important message she could share with her community, Christina said, "You are deserving of happiness and an easier time. It's possible if you keep trying."
