The goal of Family Treatment Docket is to reunify parents and their children while supporting the parents with services to help maintain their sobriety.

Services Available

Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)
Aftercare
Bi-weekly NA/AA Meetings
Weekly Observed Drug Screens
Individual Counseling
Substance Abuse Case Management
Medication Management for MAT (Suboxone) and/or Mental Health
Weekly court hearings on Wednesday until you start to phase up (switches to bi-weekly and then monthly)
Identifying a Sponsor

Assistance Available

Finding Housing
Locating Employment
Budgeting
Transportation to Appointments
Link to Community Resources
Communicating with necessary parties regarding pending criminal matters and your participation in the program
Modifying/lifting the safety plan quicker (than a normal case timeframe) due to the high level of accountability in the program

Community Services
