Horizon Behavioral Health shares messages of hope and resiliency as students return to school

Lynchburg, **VA** – The 2020 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) showed an increasing trend in feelings of sadness and hopelessness amongst high school students in Lynchburg over the past five years (<u>LCS School Health Advisory Committee</u>). Similarly, only 30% of adults in the Unites States, ages 18 and older, reported feeling hopeful about the future in the 2021 Stress in America Survey (<u>American Psychological Association</u>).

Horizon Behavioral Health is proud to invest in the future growth and wellbeing of residents in Central Virginia by emphasizing the importance of positive messaging as a resiliency factor for building safe, happy, and healthy communities.

"The science behind resiliency shows us that messages of hope and trusted support systems are equally impactful for all ages, across all neighborhoods, and all people," says Januwaa Davis, Prevention Program Manager at Horizon. "In the face of an ever-changing landscape at home, at school, and at play, our ability to respond to stress, everyday challenges, and unexpected setbacks are crucial in creating a nourishing environment where youth, adults, and families can thrive as they aspire to reach their goals."

Back by popular demand, Horizon is offering yard signs to the community to encourage neighborhoods to build their resiliency with positive messages of hope. Yard signs will be made available at no cost to individuals residing in the Counties of Amherst, Appomattox, Bedford, Campbell, and the City of Lynchburg.
